Legal basis

Processing is necessary for compliance with a legal obligation of the controller pursuant to Article 6(1)(c) of the EU Regulation (GDPR) and Section 13(1)(c) of Act No. 18/2018 Coll. and based on Act No. 121/2022 Coll. on Contributions from European Union Funds and on the Amendment and Supplementation of Certain Acts.

Scope of personal data

First name, last name, personal identification number/participant identifier, date of birth, gender, age, location, municipality, residential address, private phone number, private email address, employment status, education.

Retention period

During the implementation period of the national project Integration, as well as after its completion, until December 31, 2036.

Recipients

Controller and third parties based on applicable legal regulations (e.g., supervisory bodies, audit bodies, Ministry of the Interior of the Slovak Republic, Ministry of Labour, Social Affairs, and Family of the Slovak Republic).

Your rights in data protection

Right of access – You have the right to obtain a copy of the personal data we hold about you, as well as information on how we use your personal data. In most cases, your personal data will be provided to you in written form unless you request an alternative method of provision. If you request this information electronically, it will be provided to you electronically, if technically possible.

Right to rectification – We take appropriate measures to ensure the accuracy, completeness, and up-to-date nature of the information we hold about you. If you believe that the data we hold is inaccurate, incomplete, or outdated, please do not hesitate to ask us to correct, update, or complete this information.

Right to erasure (right to be forgotten) – You have the right to request the deletion of your personal data, for example, if the personal data we hold about you is no longer necessary for the fulfillment of the original purpose of processing. However, your rights must be assessed in light of all relevant circumstances. For instance, we may have certain legal and regulatory obligations, which means we may not be able to comply with your request.

Right to restriction of processing – Under certain circumstances, you have the right to request that we stop using your personal data. This applies, for example, in cases where you believe that the personal data we hold about you may be inaccurate, or if you believe that we no longer need to use your personal data.

Right to data portability – Under certain circumstances, you have the right to request the transfer of your personal data that you have provided to us, to another third party of your choice. However, the right to data portability applies only to personal data we have obtained from you based on consent or under a contract to which you are a party.

Right to refuse the further sending of commercial communications/newsletters to their provided e-mail address – This option must be available upon initial registration and subsequently in each individual commercial communication. Refusing to receive further communications is free of charge for the data subject.



Right to object – You have the right to object to the processing of data based on our legitimate interests. If we do not have a compelling legitimate reason for processing and you submit an objection, We will no longer process your personal data.

Right to file a proposal to initiate personal data protection proceedings – If you believe that your personal data is being processed unfairly or unlawfully, you have the right to file a complaint with the supervisory authority, which is the Office for Personal Data Protection of the Slovak Republic, Hraničná 12, 820 07 Bratislava 27; phone number: +421 /2/ 3231 3214; e-mail: statny.dozor@pdp.gov.sk, web: dataprotection.gov.sk.
